DEBATE TEAM NUMBER ONE, TWICE ONCE AGAIN Eagle Debate has gained recognition by winning one of the largest and most

competitive tournaments in the nation. Twohundred-ten debaters from 33 colleges and universities attended the 65th annual Linfield College Tournament in McMinnville, OR on Nov. 14 - 16. With 9 wins to 1 loss record. Jacob Witt and Josh Brittingham won 1st Place senior debate. Then Troy Anderson and James Stewart, with an 8 to 2 record. won 1st Place junior division. NC was the only school with two teams in semi-finals. The team of Doug Lloyd and Paul Nystrom won an octa-finalist (top 16) award in junior division. Sveta Zlatarva and Autumn Donnell also won an octa-finalist award in novice division. Other wins: Jacob 9th best senior debate speaker, finalist in senior impromptu; Troy 10th best junior debate speaker; Sveta 2nd place junior extemp; Paul 3rd place junior extemp. The next tournament is the World Championships to be held in Athens, Greece in late December.
