CONGRATULATIONS TO Brian Watson and **Katie Park** of the Northwest College Track & Field team. Brian and Katie competed in the Seattle 1/2 marathon last weekend. Brian finished the 13.1 mile race in 1 hour 26.56 minutes to place 145th out of over 4500 runners. Katie finished 252nd out of over 4500 runners in a time of 1 hour 32:08 minutes, which is a mere 8 seconds from the NAIA automatic qualifying mark for the National Championships. Her mark may stand as a provisional qualifier for Nationals. Katie was also 2nd place in her age division out of 103 runners. Great job!
