DID YOU SIGN UP FOR MATH 151 FOR THE SPRING '98 SEMESTER?

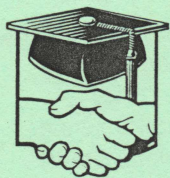
If so, you need to take the pre-requisite Math entrance exam prior to Dec. 19. Contact Esther Harmon at ext. 5226 for an appointment.

REMINDER: ALL LIBRARY BOOKS are due back December 19th. Overdue fines are to be paid by this date.



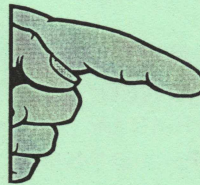
If you are planning to **graduate in the 1997-98 school year**, be sure to come to the Registrar's Office and fill out a Graduation Application so we can do an audit for you.
