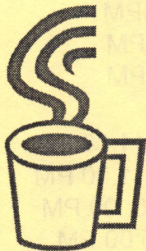

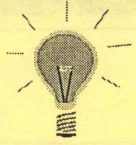
ASIA AWARENESS ON-SITE SEMINAR, BEIJING, CHINA, May 13-27, 1998.

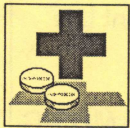


CALLING ALL EDUCATION FRESHMEN

Debaters Take Third Straight Win

The team of Troy Anderson and James Stewart won Second Place at the Pacific Cup debate tournament held at the University of British Columbia on February 13 - 15. 20 teams from 11 colleges and universities attended, coming from as far away as Saskatchewan, Louisiana and Los Angeles. After 6 pre-elimination rounds, Troy and James won their quarter and semi final rounds to face the University of Alberta in finals, held before an audience of all tournament participants. Northwest debated affirmative on a topic asking for a repeal of the North American Free Trade Act. This is the third tournament win in a row. In the past few weeks, Northwest debaters took third place at Willamette U. and Second Place at WWU.
