N.C. TRACK NEWS

Northwest College Freshman Tanya Belliard, from Fountain Hills, AZ, won the Cascade Conference Heptathlon Championships in Klamath Falls, Oregon, held on Monday and Tuesday (4/13-4/14) last week.

Tanya won the High Jump and the 800m events of the 7 event heptathlon and scored enough points in the other 5 events to lead the competition from the second event on. After the four events of day 1 Tanya held a 75 point lead over Jodi Sager of Southern Oregon University. After the 5th event on day 2 Tanya's lead was at 42 points and after 6 events she held a mere 3 point lead with only the 800m race to go. However, Tanya dominated the 800m posting a time of 2:30.8, which was 9 seconds faster than the next finisher.

Final scores for the top 3 finishers were:

- 1. Tanya Belliard-Northwest College, 3790 points.
- 2. Jodi Sager-Southern Oregon University, 3684 points
- 3. Keri Slater-Southern Oregon University, 3293 points.

This is the first Cascade Conference Championship for any individual or sport at Northwest College.
