## DEBATE WINNING STREAK CONTINUES

Following a first place win at Lower Columbia the week before, NC debaters won recognition again at the Linfield College Debate tournament last weekend. **Jacob Witt** and **Joshua Brittingham** took **Third Place** at the 68th annual speech contest held in McMinnville, Oregon. The two men were the only team out of 25 to have a 6 wins to 0 loss record going into finals. 25 senior division teams attended from 21 colleges and universities, including the U of O, OSU, the U of Nevada, U of Alaska, Humbolt State (CA) and Claremont (CA).

In addition, the team of **James Stewart** and **Paul Nystrom** won a **Quarter Finalist** award in senior division. Stewart and Nystrom were the second highest ranked team out of 25 going into finals with a 5 to 1 win - loss record. The junior team of **Sveta Zlatareva** and **Autumn Donnell** won speaker awards. Zlatareva was 3rd best and Donnell was 5th best junior division speakers out of 50. The novice team of **Megan Calkins** and **Jonathan Alberg** won a **Quarter Finalist** award. Calkins was ranked as first place best novice speaker. Alberg was 5th best novice speaker out of 48.

Topics announced fifteen minutes before each round concerned Iraq, feminism, the right of privacy, the religious right, corporate welfare, indigenous cultures and the election process.

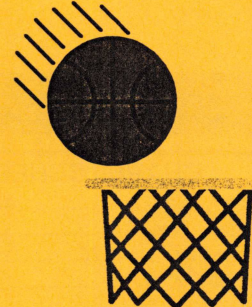
