

ANOTHER DEBATE VICTORY

Congratulations to James
Stewart and Paul Nystrom for winning
first place at Portland Community
College's debate tournament on January
15th and 16th. Stewart and Nystrom

had a nine wins to one loss record, the best of any of the 58 teams. Twenty colleges and universities, including Texas Southern University, Oregon State, University of Alaska and Willamette University, brought 36 senior and 22 novice division teams.

The Eagles faced Portland State University in the final round, held before an audience of tournament participants and coaches. The topic was "This House believes that the best man for the job is a woman." Portland State affirmed the resolution and argued that the Republican Party should nominate Elizabeth Dole for president in 2000. Stewart and Nystrom argued that the GOP would be more successful to make Dole vice president.

Other Portland awards: Josh Brittingham and Jacob Witt won a quarter finalist award in senior debate. John Behr and Jonathan Alberg won second place in novice debate. Jonathan was the seventh best novice speaker. Stewart was ranked the fourth best and Nystrom the sixth best senior speaker.
