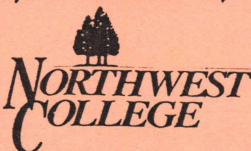

SPECIAL NOTICE - - MARRIED STUDENTS: The Kirkland Food Bank is under new management and the food supply is not as plentiful as last year. The food bank manager has requested that our married students come to the food bank to fill out an application and receive assistance. The location is: **KIRKLAND FOOD BANK, Holy Spirit Lutheran Church, 10021 NE 124th Street, Kirkland.** To qualify, your income must be not more than: 2 people, \$12,630; 3 people, \$15,840; and 4 people, \$18,050.

Food is dispersed Thursdays, 12:00 - 2:00 PM. You may pick up a number at 9:30 AM so that you won't have to stand in line. People are served according to their number. After the 1st week in December, you may file an application any day but Thursday.

If you cannot be present on Thursday between 12:00 and 2:00 PM, you can advise them, and reserve a bag of food for a more convenient pick-up. **THIS MEANS** that we will discontinue the Thursday food bank distribution on Campus. There will however, be a distribution of baked goods on Mondays in the laundry room near unit 31, The Firs, at 5:00 - 5:30. **THIS SERVICE IS AVAILABLE TO ALL MARRIED STUDENTS, AND SINGLE PARENT STUDENTS, THOSE LIVING OFF CAMPUS AS WELL AS THOSE IN THE FIRS.** Our MS Pantry continues to supply groceries for those times when your cupboard is bare. In order to clarify the requirements regarding the Freshman Scholarships, please note the following. Renewal of the scholarship is based on:

- 1. Maintaining a 2.5 GPA in Freshman year.**
- 2. Maintaining a 3.0 GPA each year thereafter.**
- 3. Maintenance of satisfactory citizenship record.**
- 4. Payment in full of student account each semester.**
