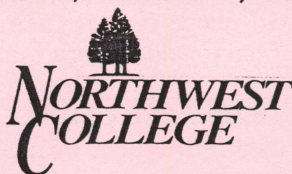

SUMMER SCHOOL REGISTRATION

If you are doing Internship/Practicums or Independent Studies you must register for these in the same way.

A 15% Tuition Credit will be extended to Assemblies of God ministers, missionaries, chaplains, and full time administrators/teachers in K-12 Christian schools (and spouses, dependents). The same will apply to spouses of NC students. Additional Tuition Credit, up to a maximum of 50 % may be available based upon student need as determined by the Financial Aid Form (FAF) submitted to College Scholarship Service (CSS). - Enrollment Services
