

FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

In order to clarify the requirements regarding the **Freshman Scholarship**, please note the following: Renewal of the scholarship is based on:

- 1. Maintaining a 2.5 GPA in Freshman year.
- 2. Maintaining a 3.0 GPA each year thereafter.
- 3. Maintenance of satisfactory citizenship record.
- 4. Payment in full of student account each semester.

FINANCIAL AID FOR 92-93 ACADEMIC YEAR: Please note that the new date for submitting financial aid applications to Northwest College is March 1, 1992. Submit your financial aid applications to College Scholarship service by January 31. Remember that 1991 income tax records are needed as well so file early! Those applicants submitting all of the necessary documents by March 1st will receive priority consideration.
