Don Argue, Ed.D. President

Dr. Don Argue was elected the fifth president of Northwest College. He began his presidential duties July 1, 1998.

Dr. Argue previously held the position of president of the National Association of Evangelicals in Wheaton, Illinois. He directed efforts for evangelical Christians that directly and indirectly benefited over 27 million people. This included approximately 42,500 congregations nationwide as well as several hundred independent churches, and 289 parachurch ministries and educational institutions.

Prior to Dr. Argue's office with the NAE, he served as president of North Central Bible University in Minneapolis, Minnesota, for sixteen years. Under his leadership the college grew from an enrollment of 401 to over 1,500 and received the *Christianity Today Decade of Growth Award* in recognition of its being the fastest growing college of its kind in the nation during the 1980's.

A graduate of Central Bible College, Dr. Argue earned a masters degree at Santa Clara University, California and a doctorate at the University of the Pacific, California. He has also done postgraduate study at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary, South Hamilton, Massachusetts; and Regent College, Vancouver, Canada.

In prior years he served as dean of students and campus pastor at Evangel University in Springfield, Missouri. He was also pastor of churches in San Jose and Morgan Hill, California.

We welcome Dr. Argue and his wife, Pat, to Northwest College and look forward to their leadership, vision and dreams for the future of Northwest College.
