Rev. Dennis A. Davis

Rev. Denny Davis was named the fourth President of Northwest College in May, 1990. He and his wife, Nancy, moved to Kirkland in mid-summer, and he assumed his new duties on August 1st.

Rev. Davis graduated from Northwest College in 1956, and later served as its Alumni President and also on its Board of Directors. He was honored by the College as Alumnus of the Year in 1975, and with selection to the Delta Epsilon Chi Honor Society in 1976.

Rev. Davis has had extensive domestic and international experience as an evangelist and speaker, and he has pastored in California and Oregon. He pastored People's Church in Salem, Oregon for twenty years; during that span the church saw attendance increase 700 percent. From 1987 until this summer Rev.
