Dr. J. EDWIN ORR

Dr. J. Edwin Orr, Irish-born resident of California, has been deeply involved in a program of worldwide spiritual revival for the last three decades, and has visited 150 of the world's 160 countries. He is a professor of History and Missions in the School of World Missions at Fuller Theological Seminary (Pasadena, California). He spends much of his time ministering to the needs of the academic community in this country and abroad. Many of these activities are sponsored by the Staley Foundation for Distinguished Christian Scholars.

Dr. Orr received his M.A. from Northwestern University, Th.D. from Northern Baptist Theological Seminary, Ph.D. from Oxford University (England), and Ed.D. from U.C.L.A. Research has won him university doctorates in Europe, Asia, Africa, and America. He is an entertaining speaker, and punctuates his addresses with a native Irish humor.

He is the author of 30 books, with a circulation of about a million in a dozen languages. Among his more popular books are *Second Evangelical Awakening*, *Full Surrender*, *Faith That Makes Sense*, *The Light of the Nations*, *Campus Aflame*, *One Hundred Questions About God*, and *Can God?* He is editing material for a series of volumes on awakenings in various major sectors of the world — India, Africa, the Orient and Latin America.

Dr. Orr is a Life Fellow of the Royal Geographical Society, the American Geographical Society and the Royal Historical Society. In addition, he is a member of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, American Historical Association, Royal Society of Literature and the American Scientific Affiliation of Theology and Science.
