"Pursuant to the provisions of HEB 1501, the Higher Education Coordinating Board has developed the approximate level of state supported financial aid received by students at Northwest College. The legislation requires that beginning with the 1993 fall term, each institution of higher education provides students with information of the estimated amount the state is contributing to the support of their education."

The estimated amount of state supported financial aid by student FTE at your institution is \$336. This amount was derived by dividing the total projected financial aid for the 1993-94 academic year by the estimated enrollment to arrive at the approximate amount of state supported financial aid per enrolled student at FTE. The estimate of 1995 state supported financial aid by institution includes both need based and non-based assistance."
