

# **Recognitions and Honors**

#### **Honorary Doctorates**

#### DR. LEWIS SHELTON

#### AWARDED HONORARY DOCTORATE IN DECEMBER 2009

Rev. Lewis R. Shelton was named president of Bethany University on January 13, 2009, following five months of service as acting president. Rev. Shelton is an alumnus of Bethany University, from which he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Music. He also holds a Master of Arts in Biblical Literature from the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary in Springfield, Missouri.

Rev. Shelton's career has focused primarily on ministry within the fellowship of the Assemblies of God, the organization with which he holds ministerial credentials. Licensed in 1969 and ordained in 1979, Rev. Shelton served Assemblies of God congregations in California and Nevada as minister of music for 13 years and congregations in Oregon as senior pastor for 28 years. Most recently, he completed 22 years as Senior Pastor of First Assembly of God in Albany, Oregon. Under his leadership, the congregation grew from 900 to over 1300. During his years of ministry, Pastor Shelton often served as an educator in both public and private schools. He has taught in colleges in Oregon and California and has been a visiting professor for institutions in Singapore, Madagascar, and Fiji.

#### Dr. Gordon Fee

#### AWARDED HONORARY DOCTORATE IN APRIL 2010

Dr. Gordon Fee received B.A. and M.A. degrees from Seattle Pacific University and a Ph.D. from the University of Southern California. He attributes much of his spiritual fervor to his father, Donald Fee, who was an Assemblies of God pastor and served as a faculty member here at Northwest University for 23 years. The Fee building on campus was named in honor of Donald Fee.

Dr. Fee's love of teaching transported him to Southern California College, Wheaton College in Illinois, and Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary. He currently holds the rank of Professor Emeritus at Regent College in Vancouver, B.C. Dr. Fee is a New Testament scholar and one of the foremost experts in the area of pneumatology and textual criticism of the New Testament. He has authored several books including God's Empowering Presence, How to Read the Bible for All Its Worth, How to Read the Bible Book by Book, Gospel and Spirit, Listening to the Spirit in the Text, New Testament Exegesis, as well as highly respected commentaries on 1st Corinthians, Philippians, 1st and 2nd Timothy, and Titus. He has served on the advisory board of the International Institute for Christian Studies and was a member of the Committee on Bible Translation that translated the NIV version and its revision.

Dr. Fee is an ordained minister with the Assemblies of God. He is married to Maudine, and they have four grown children and several grandchildren.

#### Sigma Chi Pi

Sigma Chi Pi is an honor society established for graduates of endorsed Assemblies of God colleges. The name of the honor society, Sigma Chi Pi, stands for "Diligent Christian Leaders," taken from Romans 12:8, "one who leads, with diligence." The faculty of Northwest University choose honorees from graduates and alumni exhibiting outstanding academic scholarship, approved Christian character, and recognizable achievement in leadership, service, or vocation.

#### DEAN CURRY

Rev. Dean Curry is a 1990 graduate of Northwest University and a nationally sought-after public speaker, motivator, teacher, and mentor who is passionate about extending Jesus' message of hope to the world.

In 2006, he co-founded The Global Neighbor Project, a compassionate, community-based outreach to the region of Lesotho, Africa. As the Lead Pastor at Life Center in Tacoma, Washington, Rev. Curry shepherds one of the largest multigenerational congregations in the state, with sister programs ranging from a K-12 preparatory school to a full-service retirement facility. He has been married to his wife, Anne for 20 years and they have two children, Drew and Gabby.

#### DANIEL RUSSELL

Dr. Daniel Russell graduated Magna Cum Laude from Northwest University in 1990 with a B.A. in Religion and Philosophy. He completed a second B.A. in Philosophy and Greek, an M.A. in Philosophy, and a Ph.D. in Philosophy at the University of Arizona. Dr. Russell joined the faculty of Wichita State University in 2000. He plans to transition to the University of Arizona in the 2011-12 academic year. He has authored the books *Happiness, Virtue, and The Self*, and *Practical Intelligence and the Virtues*. He received the John R. Barrier Distinguished Teaching Award in 2009.

# The University Seal

The Northwest University seal includes these elements:

- An open Bible, for our commitment to God's Word;
- The lamp of knowledge, for our tradition of scholarship;
- A dove, for our reliance on the Holy Spirit's leading and power;

• A cross, for the centrality of Christ in all we do;

- A braid, for the bonds of Christian fellowship;
- The year 1934, for the year of Northwest's founding; and
- The Latin motto, Vocationem Dei Gerite, which is translated "carry, carry out, and be characterized by God's calling." This phrase reconfirms the University's motto: Carry the Call, with heart, head, and hand.



# The Pageantry of Academic Regalia

Traditional academic attire originated in the middle ages as the regular garb of scholars. In the unheated buildings and lecture halls of the day, the robes, hoods and caps were very practical.

The **GOWN** was useful outerwear, and it served to equalize class and wealth distinctions in the community of scholars. Today, in the U.S., the gown is customarily black, though it may be one of the colors of the school. Bachelor gowns are simple and are worn closed, while masters' gowns are frequently worn open at the front. The doctoral gown commonly has trim down the front and three velvet bars on the sleeves, in black or in the color of the degree field.

The **HOOD** originated as a practical head covering but today it is strictly ceremonial. It is commonly worn by those holding master's or doctoral degrees and differs in length according to the degree. Hoods are lined with the colors of the conferring institution, and trimmed with an edging in the color of the degree field. The act of "hooding" is part of the traditional ceremony conferring advanced degrees.

The "Oxford" **CAP** or **MORTARBOARD** possibly developed as a ceremonial combination of a close-fitting indoor cap and a soft square-topped outdoor cap. (Some schools use a type of beret or tam for doctoral degrees.)

The **TASSEL** is customarily worn on the left by degree holders, thus bachelor's degree candidates wear the tassel on the right until the symbolic "moving of the tassel" at a climactic point in the graduation ceremony.

Degree fields are identifiable from this commonly used color scheme: Business—Drab, Economics—Copper, Education—Light Blue, Fine Arts—Brown, Humanities—White, Journalism—Crimson, Law—Purple, Library Science—Lemon, Medicine—Green, Music—Pink, Nursing—Salmon, Oratory (Speech)—Silver Gray, Philosophy—Dark Blue, Physical Education—Sage Green, Science—Golden Yellow, Social Work—Citron, Theology—Scarlet.

The MACE is the symbol of authority of the Faculty and is carried in the Commencement Processional by the official representative of the Faculty, the Faculty Marshal. The central emblem of the mace is the University seal.

# Northwest University History

Northwest University was founded by the Northwest District Council of the Assemblies of God and opened to students on October 1, 1934. The District Presbytery appointed Dr. Henry H. Ness to be the first president. Northwest was housed in the facilities of Hollywood Temple, Seattle, Washington, for the first twenty-five years of its existence. Dr. C.E. Butterfield succeeded Dr. Ness in 1949, and Dr. D.V. Hurst assumed the presidency in 1966. In 1990 he was succeeded by Dr. Dennis A. Davis, who served until 1998. Dr. Don Argue served as president from 1998 to 2007 and currently serves as Chancellor. Dr. Joseph Castleberry was inaugurated in the fall of 2007 as the sixth president.

Originally known as Northwest Bible Institute, its name was changed to Northwest Bible College in 1949 and to Northwest College of the Assemblies of God in 1962. In January 2005, Northwest College officially became Northwest University.

Academically, Northwest progressed from a three-year to a four-year curriculum in 1948, and in 1955 a liberal arts division was organized. Regional accreditation was obtained by 1973 with the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities. Now, as a university, Northwest grants both undergraduate and graduate degrees.

In 1958, Northwest secured a new thirty-five acre campus in Kirkland, in the greater metropolitan area of Seattle. Since then 21 acres have been added to comprise the current fifty-six acre campus. Located at 108th Avenue NE and NE 53rd Street, just ten miles from downtown Seattle, the campus is an ideal setting for study, recreation, and inspiration. The campus is near area corporations, resulting in employment opportunities for students and alumni.

In 1992, Northwest University joined the Council for Christian Colleges and Universities, an international association of more than 181 Christ-centered, liberal arts and sciences colleges, universities, and affiliate institutions in 24 countries.

Over the years, the University's alumni have engaged in full-time Christian service in professional, business, or vocational occupations in fulfillment of Northwest University's commitment to Carry the Call, with heart, head, and hand.
