Reporting Fires

Federal law requires NU to maintain a fire log for fires that occur on our campuses. Fires that must be reported include emergency situations involving fires that necessitated a call to 9-1-1 for fire department assistance, as well as minor fires, such as a small trash can fire or a cooking fire that was easily extinguished without assistance. Fires can be reported by anyone, regardless of the individual's association with NU.

Student housing fires reported to any official at NU must be documented to Campus Security. An official is any person who has the authority and the duty to take action or respond to particular issues on behalf of the institution.



Both the fire log and the fire reporting form are available on the <u>Campus Security</u> website.
