Wellness Center Expansion

The Wellness Center is announcing an expansion of its student health services. Beginning early in the 2012 fall semester, the Wellness Center will provide primary health care and general wellness services through the addition of both a full-time nurse and a part-time nurse practitioner. These new services will provide Kirkland campus students with a broader scope of health services. Further, the Center will be adding a second full-time licensed counselor to the Center staff to serve the growing student population.

All Kirkland Campus day-program students taking 4 or more credits will be charged a \$70/per semester Health and Wellness fee to pay for the additional services. LEAP and Graduate students can access Wellness Center health or counseling services by appointment (as available) for a \$25 fee per visit.

On both the national and local level, there has been a significant increase in demand for health and counseling services on University campuses. Student health is an important factor in student academic success. Responding to the increasing need for healthcare services, this expansion seeks to support student academic success and provide a convenient and less expensive option for general healthcare services.
