Hey Pastor Phil,

Last week at lighthouse was probably my favorite night. I realize that is a big statement, but I say it almost every week. Anyway, 17 students showed up which was the most I've seen this year or last. Most were new students!

I wanted to share a quick testimony about what Jesus has been doing in Mike over these past few weeks. Mike is a homeless white 20 something year old who is addicted to heroin like many on the streets. We've known him since the end of last year. Three or four weeks ago we found him with bandages on his arm because he was taken to the hospital when found overdosed on the sidewalk. It wasn't a coincidence we got to meet him that night though he was out of it a little. A couple weeks later we saw him and he was asking us what we knew about Mormons because he was involved in some of their activities. We prayed for him for deliverance and I'm pretty sure we all felt God strongly. As we prayed I got a word of knowledge and asked him if he'd been having bad nightmares. He said yes. The next week he came up to us excitedly and said the nightmares were gone and that every time we prayed for him miracles happened. He asked for prayer to finally kick his heroin addiction and the same for his girlfriend! There are very interesting dynamics in this guy's life and the Lord is after him in a real way. P. Phil as we pray these people are getting physically encountered. This is just one of the stories.
