Psalm 18:28-33


Dear NU Community,

Here David says he can scale a wall, because God's way is perfect and His Word is flawless. A perfect God could have nothing less than perfect communication with His people. It is we who read hastily, skip prayer, and fail to meditate on His Word, who find it confusing. The best gift in the world, next to the Word incarnate, Jesus Himself, is God's written Word, and it will ignite your heart if you give it a chance."

I am sure that, like me, you have many things on your mind at the beginning of this week. As Keller reminds us, there is no peace in to-do lists or in effort, unless we first stay our minds on Jesus and His Word. If we would give our thoughts to Jesus today and allow Him to fill our minds and souls with His presence, we would find that "He makes [our] feet like the feet of a deer; He causes [us] to stand on the heights". Join me in taking a moment to give this day and week to Jesus in your heart, and to receive His strength.
