Among many outstanding personal experiences, there was one particularly profound moment. I was nervous to share this word because the audience consisted mostly of older people and any one of them could have a heart condition. The Holy Spirit works in us the same way He worked in the apostle Peter when he was “filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke with boldness” ([Acts 4:7-8](#)).

He gives us power to do more than we can do in our own strength. Every day, I am learning more about His important role in my life and how much He wants to use me to impact people.
