## Son's Death Tragic End To Reunion

It was a long time since Mrs. Sophia Will, of 434 E. 72d St., had seen all of her boys together.

Three of them are ministers, one is in the army, and the fifth of her sons, Emil B. Will, 20, was to graduate from the Northwest Bible Institute, Seattle, in May, 1947.

Mrs. Will decided to "take a vacation" and go to Dickinson, N. D., for a family reunion. Her two daughters and one of the sons, of

Seattle, were going with her.

An hour before they left, Mrs. Will received a telegram with the tragic news that Emil had been in an automobile accident in Dickinson and was not expected to live. Emil died last Saturday.
