FOREMOST FRENCH COMPOSER OF HIS TIME INFLUENCED MANY 20TH CENTURY COMPOSERS HIS WORKS AFFECTED HOW MUSIC IS TAUGHT STUDIED SCHUMANN & LISZT SLOWLY WENT DEAF & DIED OF PNEUMONIA
