The Northwest University Music Department has over 67 music majors and 16 music minors. There are four full-time professors, 18 adjuncts, one media director and one secretary. Students can major in Music, Music Education, Music Ministry, or Contemporary Music Industry. The department also offers private lessons in most instruments and voice to all students. This year 117 students are taking lessons.

There are five music ensembles in the Music Department. Bill Owen directs the Concert Choir which is open to all students. Brenda Rasmussen directs the Northwest Choralons, the largest choir on campus. Ken Prettyman directs the Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band and Synergy, the vocal jazz ensemble. Auditions for the ensembles happen the first week of classes.

The Wind Ensemble and Jazz Band do not require auditions.
