The Northwest University Music Department has over 67 music majors and 16 music minors. There are four full-time professors, 18 adjuncts, one media director and an administrative assistant.

Students can major in Music, Music Education, Music Ministry, or Contemporary Music Industry. The department also offers private lessons in most instruments and voice to all students. This year 119 students are taking lessons.

There are five music ensembles in the Music Department. Department Head & Associate Professor Bill Owen directs the Concert Choir, and Assistant Professor Brenda Rasmussen directs the Northwest Choralons choir. Associate Professor Ken Prettyman directs the Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band and Synergy, the vocal jazz ensemble. Associate Professor Mizue Fells oversees Music Theory and Piano Studies. Auditions for the ensembles happen the first week of classes. The Wind Ensemble and Jazz Band do not require auditions.
