Northwest University Christmas concerts are Friday, December 8th, 7:30 p.m. and Saturday, December 9th at 3:00 p.m. here in the Chapel. Tickets are available by phone, mail, or in person. Please call 458-889-5255 or email to music@northwestu.edu Advance tickets are \$8 adults and \$6 students/seniors. Tickets at the door will be \$10-adults and \$8-students/seniors. Children 12 and under are free.

Students who take private lessons perform for recitals. The intermediate/advanced vocal recital is Tuesday, November 28. The intermediate instrumental recital is Tuesday, November 21, and the advanced instrumental recital is Tuesday, December 5. All recitals start at 7:00 p.m. and are here in the Chapel. Admission is free.

The Northwest University Music Department has over 67 music majors and 16 music minors. There are four full-time professors, 18 adjuncts, one media director and one secretary. Students can major in Music, Music Education, Music Ministry, or Contemporary Music Industry. The department also offers private lessons to all students. This year 119 students are taking lessons. Vocal and most instruments are available.

The Music Department will be holding scholarship auditions for the upcoming school year on Saturday, January 20 and Saturday, February 17, 2007 from 9:00 a.m to 4:00 p.m. in the Chapel. Students must prepare two pieces and should contact the Music Department Secretary for information at 425-889-5255 or by email at music@northwestu.edu.

There are six music ensembles in the Music Department. Bill Owen directs the select Chamber Choir and also the Concert Choir which is open to all students. Brenda Rasmussen directs the Northwest Choralons, the largest choir on campus. Ken Prettyman directs the Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band and Synergy, the vocal jazz ensemble. Auditions for the ensembles happen the first week of classes. The Wind Ensemble and Jazz Band do not require auditions.
