The Choirs

This Sunday, April 30, the chamber and concert choirs will be singing at Bellevue Christian Reformed Church. On May 7-15, 61 members of the combined choirs will be touring England and Wales. They will be singing in the Canterbury, Winchester, Bristol and Southwark cathedrals, Bath Abbey, Holy Trinity Church in Stratford, and Great St. Mary's Church in Cambridge. They will also be performing an exchange concert with the Penarth Welsh Male Choir in Cardiff, Wales.

Ensembles

The music department offers six different ensembles and one does not have to be a music major to join. They are the Northwest Choralons, led by Brenda Rasmussen; chamber singers and concert choir, led by Bill Owen; wind ensemble, jazz band and vocal jazz, led by Ken Prettyman. Auditions for these groups are held during the first week of classes. All groups perform one major concert a semester and perform off campus as well.

The Department

The Northwest University Music Department offers four different degree programs in which the students may specialize in music, music education, music industry or music ministry. Students can also minor in music. The department has over 65 music majors and 21 music minors. There are four full time professors, three part time professors, ten adjuncts, one media director and one secretary. The department also offers private lessons to all students. Most types of lessons are available. Lesson sign ups will happen the first week of classes.

The University

Since 1934, Northwest University has successfully prepared students for service and leadership in Kirkland, Washington. Over 1,161 students choose from more than 50 academic programs including-but not limited to-ministry, business, nursing, and education. Students are offered creative challenges involving debate, drama, music, ministry, and sports. The school is accredited by the Northwest Commission of Colleges and Universities and is a member of the Council for Christian Colleges and Universities.

Graduation

Northwest University's baccalaureate service is held next Friday, May 5 at 7:00 P.M. here in the chapel. The Northwest Choralons will be performing. The commencement service is held on Saturday, May 6 at 10:00 A.M. at Overlake Christian Church in Redmond. The wind ensemble, concert choir and chamber singers will be performing.
