The Mix It Up Jazz Concert is the first full student concert of the year. We had a special guest concert, featuring David Boyer, in which both the jazz band and the vocal jazz ensembles performed in October. We have also had Professor K.R. Prettyman conduct a choral recital on November 5th for his Doctorate of Musical Arts from the University of Washington. The jazz ensembles have performed for various events during the year such as singing the national anthem at a Thunderbirds game or playing for the Northwest College Spring Banquet. This next year they can be seen at the Lionel Hampton Jazz Festival in February and the Apple Blossom Festival in May.

The next music department event will be the Christmas concerts held on Friday, December 3 and Saturday, December 4. They will both be held in the Butterfield Chapel at Northwest College at 7:30 P.M. Tickets are \$7 adults and \$5 students and seniors. They may be purchased over the phone at 425-889-5255 or in person at the door. These concerts will feature the wind ensemble, directed by Ken Prettyman; the Northwest Choralons, directed by Brenda Rasmussen; and the concert choir, directed by Bill Owen.

The music department program at Northwest College has over sixty music majors, four full time professors, seven part time instructors, ten private lesson adjuncts, one media director and an administrative assistant. The department offers a Bachelor of Arts or a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Music. Music Education, Music Industry, or Music Ministry, Students may also minor in music. The Music Education program is certified through the State of Washington. The department offers five ensembles-concert choir, jazz band, Northwest Choralons, wind ensemble, and vocal jazz that are open to all students regardless of major. Auditions for these groups are typically held at the beginning of the school year. Auditions for music scholarships are held throughout the year until the end of March.
