The concert choir will be touring this spring to various churches such as the First Free Methodist in Seattle,
First Presbyterian of Bellevue, Cedar Park Assembly in Bothell, and University Presbyterian of Seattle.

*The wind ensemble spring concert will be held on Friday, April 15 here in the chapel. Professor Ken
Prettyman, the director, conducted his choral recital on November 5th for his Doctorate of Musical Arts
from the University of Washington. He is also the director of the jazz band and vocal jazz ensembles.*

*The music department program here at Northwest College has over sixty music majors, four full time
professors, seven part time instructors, ten adjunct professors, one media director and an administrative
assistant. The department offers a Bachelor of Arts or a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Music, Music Education,
Music Industry, or Music Ministry. Students may also minor in music. The Music Education program is
certified through the State of Washington.*

*The department offers five ensembles-concert choir, jazz band, Northwest Choralons, wind ensemble,
and vocal jazz that are open to all students regardless of major. Auditions for these groups are typically
held at the beginning of the school year.*

*Auditions for music scholarships are held throughout the year until the end of March. Anyone, regardless
of major, can audition for these. Please call 425-889-5255 to receive information for audition requirements
and for an audition day and time.*

*Northwest College will officially become Northwest University as of January 1, 2005. The college is
accredited by the Northwest Commission of Colleges and Universities and is a member of the Council
for Christian Colleges and Universities.*
