The spring concert is the second concert performed this year.

You are welcome to attend the spring instrumental recital, being held in the chapel, or the spring vocal recital, being held in M-1; both recitals are on Thursday, April 22 at 7 P.M. and are free of charge.

The Northwest Music Department, offers four degree programs (B.A. or B.F.A.)-music, music education, music industry, and music ministry. Students may also minor in music.

The department has four full-time professors, twelve adjunct professors, one administrative assistant, one media director, and fifty-eight music majors. The music education program is certified through the State of Washington.

Performance groups include the Concert Choir, Jazz Band, Northwest Choralons, Vocal Jazz, and Wind Ensemble.

Auditions for the other groups are held the first week of the semester and membership in the groups is open to all students, regardless of major. All groups perform in at least one major concert per semester and perform in other venues throughout the year.
