The spring concerts are the third of three major concerts held at Northwest College.

The Northwest College Music Department, a Division of Humanities, offers four different degree programs (B.A. and B.F.A.) in which students may specialize in music, music education, music industry, or music ministry. The music education program is certified through the State of Washington.

Performance groups include the Concert Choir, Northwest Choralons, Vocal Jazz Ensemble, Instrumental Jazz Ensemble, and Wind Ensemble. Auditions for the vocal groups are held the first week of classes and membership in any of these groups is open to all students, regardless of major. All groups perform in one major concert a term and at various churches, organizations, and chapels throughout the year.

Auditions for music scholarships are held once a month during Northwest Fridays or can be scheduled through the department.
