Alumni of the Year

Miss Lillian Bach, class of 1938 (B.A. 1968).

In recognition of a lifetime of effective and faithful missionary service in Nigeria where she worked in the Central Bible College until her recent retirement, and in recognition of her sterling Christian character and faithful devotion to Christ.

The Reverend Charles Slaughter, class of 1937.

In recognition of a lifetime of quality leadership as pastor, district superintendent, as spiritual counselor, as a loving servant of Jesus Christ.

Didaskolos Awards

(honoring former faculty of the College)

Dr. Richard W. Bishop. Served the College in the 1940's and the 1950's. In recognition of his substantive and effective contribution to the work of curriculum development, to the classroom, and to the academic administration of the College, and for his commitment and faithfulness to the Lord Jesus Christ and to the work of His kingdom through the classroom and the pulpit.

Miss Estelle Crittenden, class of 1938. Served on the College faculty in the later 1940's. In recognition of dedicated and efficient service to the Lord in administration, in the classroom, and in the on-going work of the alumni association.
